The rhythm section will start the evening with a short set, following which frontline players can sit in and call tunes. It will be possible to substitute other rhythm players as the evening progresses.

If you want to play anything not in the book you need to bring your own sets of music.

There needs to be

3 copies in Concert pitch

1 copy transposed for B-flat horns

1 copy transposed for E-flat horns

Vocalists please note - we would like to able to transpose at sight but we can't. Therefore any music you bring needs to be in a key you're OK with.
