

## Problems Accessing Circulation or other EJournals

Many people have experienced problems accessing electronic journals. I hope this step by step guide using the example of the journal **Circulation** makes the process clearer.

### Accessing Circulation

- To access Electronic journals you must be logged into ATHENS. Your Athens username and password is the same as your CFS username and password.
- In Leicester Elink <http://resolver1.sirsi.co.uk> search for '**Circulation**'. You will then get the following results:

Please note - the first Highwire link has an **embargo for 12 months**. If you choose this link and try to view an article from the last 12 months you will appear to have access until you try to download the article. Then it won't work.

If you need an article from the last 12 months you need to use the second 'Journals@Ovid' link. For this demonstration I will assume you want to use the 'Journals@Ovid' link to view a recent article.



- Click on 'Go to title' next to the 'Journals@Ovid' link. You will then see the following:

- Then you will be asked to login. Use your CFS username and password.

- You will then be taken straight to the **Circulation** table of contents and will be able to view the full text.

## Other Journals

- If you do not get directly to the journal you may have to go through a similar process to the one above.
- Sometimes you get the following screen:
