Summary Description: Explore innovative approaches to this traditional textile craft, using wax resists, dyes, collage and discharge techniques on fabric and paper.

Detailed Description: 'Batik – but not as we know it' is an innovative workshop which aims to broaden the learners' skills and confidence in a unique art-form.

The workshop is very much a 'hands on' practical with on-going learner support in a friendly and supportive learning environment, experimental in nature, literally pushing the boundaries of an expressive medium with its roots as an ancient textile craft.

Learners will familiarise themselves with the tools and principles of Batik through exercises aimed at freeing and developing ideas using various wax-resists, dyeing and discharge techniques on paper and fabrics.

Objectives/Outcomes: Learners will acquire and further develop skills, confidence and knowledge in Batik, including techniques and applications, design and cultural and historical background.
