Detailed Description: Sharing stories is a wonderful way to spend time as a family and using stories to inspire craft activities, movements and song can extend the fun even further!

Each workshop will begin with an inter-active storytelling session where families can join in together and get involved. Stories may be on a particular theme, e.g. colours or a type of story, like traditional fairy tales. After the story session, families can make a craft or engage with an activity inspired by a story. Families can also join in with some movement activities and singing.

These workshops will also give parents, carers and children further ideas for more activities to be enjoyed at home.

Objectives/Outcomes:

- To encourage book and story use between parents/carers and children
- To model storytelling and story making techniques that can be used at home
- To explore different themes and topics using books, stories and craft activities
- To empower parents in using creativity with their children
- To improve speaking and listening skills
- To incorporate movement, sound and songs inspired by the stories
- To learn about the seasons, nature, animals and weather
