Summary Description: Learn how to create your own unique textured and patterned paper samples, using impressions, inlays of flowers and plants, and a host of other embellishments.

Detailed Description: Students will produce decorative papers using the Deckle Method of papermaking.

The papers will be embellished using a variety of methods, including impressing: using items such as vintage lace, and found objects to create texture and pattern; or inlay and laminating to embed items, such as pressed flowers, or seeds, within the paper.

Objectives/Outcomes: Some will have learnt a completely new skill; others will simply have had a highly enjoyable exploration of an ancient and satisfying craft technique. Many learners may even finish the workshop keen to continue papermaking experiments at home.
