Summary Description: With just soap, water and a bit elbow grease, transform colourful merino wool into your own lovely handmade felt items.

Detailed Description: Learners will gain an insight into the history of felt making and learn traditional wet hand felting techniques to produce a variety of items. No previous experiences necessary, just a desire to learn something new.

Using gorgeous soft merino wool in a variety of vibrant colours learners will be shown how to make a wall-hanging design/picture, 3d felt work – bowls, bags and purses and jewellery.

If this is a one day workshop learners will have the opportunity to make wall hanging and embellishments and then choose to make either a bowl/vase or purse or jewellery items.

Objectives/Outcomes: By the end of the course learners will have gained the necessary skills and knowledge to make a variety of decorative items ranging from wall hangings to three-dimensional items such as bags and purses.
