Summary Description: An exciting way for children and their adults to discover sculpture together, using lots of different materials to try out carving, modelling and construction techniques under the guidance of an experienced sculptor.

Detailed Description: Students will try out new techniques and materials on this family friendly project based sculpture course. Progressing through a variety of materials we will be introducing carving, modelling and construction techniques. Working either independently or collaboratively adult carers and children will produce sculptures through the development of their own ideas as they explore different media. Beginning with creating 2D drawings and collages students will learn how to progress these into 3D work. Students can bring in drawings or previous works as a springboard but will also be guided towards developing concepts individually if they have no previous experience

Objectives/Outcomes: To learn new sculptural techniques such as carving, modelling and constructing. To explore a variety of media such as wood, plaster, mesh, fabric, card, plastic, polystyrene, pva, expanding foam, paper, wire, papier-mache etc. To learn how to develop an idea from 2D (drawing and collage) into 3D.

Learning about sculptors and sculpture throughout art history. Developing independent ideas through their own personal projects. Spending quality time with family in a supportive and friendly community environment.
