Working in silver: Earrings and cufflinks

Summary Description: An opportunity to make your own pieces and learn techniques including soldering, forming, sawing, hammering, drilling, doming and filing. Suitable for both beginners and improvers.

Detailed Description: The workshop usually covers a five hour period plus a 30min break for lunch.

We start with an introduction and demonstrations. Learners cover the basic health and safety requirements needed during the day and are instructed on how to use the various tools and equipment safely through both explanation and demonstration by myself.

The learners are then able to begin making items themselves and will receive one to one help and advice as necessary. For all workshops learners will learn basic jewellery making techniques such as soldering silver, hammering textures and patterns, filing, sawing, shaping silver, cleaning and finishing the jewellery to a good standard.

Objectives/Outcomes:

Learners will learn the skills and techniques necessary to be able to produce several items of handmade silver jewellery during each workshop.
