Aspects of life drawing: Life drawing for complete beginners

Summary Description: An opportunity for absolute beginners to life drawing to find out how to render the human figure accurately and confidently. Those who wish to improve their skills are also welcome for this mix of classwork and one-to-one tuition.

Detailed Description: Following a group discussion about why life drawing is considered difficult, we begin with a variety of short poses then subjects such as ; gestural drawing, pivots, the picture plane, negative spaces, shape, shadow mapping, linkage, and subtractive drawings...amongst others.

Participants will discover that it's not as difficult as they had thought to render the human form in a 3d, convincing manner.

We will work towards a more finished piece from a longer pose.

Objectives/Outcomes: An intensive workshop, designed for total beginners of the life drawing genre. Participants will be shown fool proof, tried and tested methods of rendering the life model using various drawing media. All students will end the day with the knowledge and ability to render the human form in a three dimensional and convincing manner.
