Submitting a proposal

Many of our exhibitions are a result of the Visual Arts Manager approaching artists directly or hiring touring exhibitions from other venues. However, we are always pleased to hear from artists who would like us to consider their work, in particular those whose work addresses issues surrounding identity. Artists who are deaf or disabled are particularly encouraged to contact us.

Due to the large number of requests, it is not always possible to meet with artists in person to discuss their work. We therefore kindly ask that you submit a proposal for the attention of the Visual Arts Manager who will respond to you as soon as possible. Due to the large number of proposals that we receive there may be a delay in replying, but please be assured that we take all proposals seriously and will return all images.

Proposals should consist of the following:

- Your contact details
- Images of your work
- CV (education, exhibition history, etc)
- A short statement summarising your practice

Gallery hire

While the main exhibition space is not available for hire, it is possible for artists and groups to hire a smaller gallery on the first floor of the RACentre. Fully accessible, this space is available in blocks of four weeks for a small fee of £100 (this price may be negotiable for charities and arts-in-health related organisations). The gallery consists of approximately 28ft of running wall space, with some space for 3D work, although it should be noted that the gallery is 5.5ft wide.
