Submitting a proposal

There are several spaces at Vaughan College which can be used for art exhibitions or for showing material relating to other interests of relevance to Vaughan College. Exhibitions are selected by the Vaughan College Art Exhibition Committee. To be considered for an exhibition, artists are kindly asked to submit a proposal.

Proposals should consist of the following:

- Your contact details
- Images of your work
- CV (education, exhibition history, etc.)
- A short statement summarising your practice and exhibition idea

All exhibitions should be of a high standard in terms of content and should be well presented. The presentation may be very simple, but should be thoroughly prepared. A few display boards are available for use in addition to the wall space.

Although mounting an exhibition is the responsibility of the exhibitors, special requirements may be discussed with the Vaughan College Art Exhibition Committee.
